



Event considerations for COVID-19

Park Center is confident that by May 2022, we will be able to safely host in person gatherings with limited social distancing. However, the following provides an explanation of the considerations we have made to make the event safe and successful if the COVID-19 pandemic is still unchecked.

Attendance:

Westin Hotel's maximum capacity is 280 individuals for our event. However, Park Center will abide by the most stringent capacity guidelines per local, state, and national recommendations and make those decisions one month prior to the event and communicate that information to all guests.

Event Program and Facility:

Park Center will also include the following safety measures at the event:

- Park Center will provide anti-bacterial hand sanitizer to all guests
- Use multiple entrances and exits and discourage crowded waiting areas.
- Offer online attendance options in addition to in-person attendance
- Remind guests to safely distance between each other

FAQ

Will I receive a refund for my contribution if the event is rescheduled?

We do not plan to issue refunds; however, we will move all recognition associated with the contribution or sponsorship to the newly rescheduled event.

Will masks be required at the event?

Park Center will follow the most stringent health recommendations required by health officials.
