<b>Peer Wellness</b>	Will accept any mental health diagnosis			
<b>Substance Use Recovery</b> (IOP and OP)	Will accept any mental health diagnosis			Insurance Requirements: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All TennCare plans accepted</li> <li>• We can serve those who are uninsured or underinsured and have low income (meet the 138% federal poverty guidelines)</li> </ul>
<b>SOAR</b> (SSI/SSDI Outreach)	✓			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Single, unaccompanied adults in Davidson County</li> <li>• Must currently be in mental health treatment for at least 6-12 months or have experienced multiple psychiatric diversion/hospital stays within a 12-month period</li> <li>• Must be experiencing homelessness, in a housing crisis, or in an institution (hospital, jail, prison) without placement upon discharge</li> <li>• Cannot have an SSI/SSDI case currently pending</li> <li>• Can be working, but must be making less than substantial gainful activity (SGA) for the year</li> </ul>

<b>Emerging Adults</b> (Day Program & Housing)	✓			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For young adults (ages 18-25)</li> <li>• Must have a history of mental health hospitalization OR a history of foster care OR have very low income</li> <li>• Does not have history of sexually offensive behavior</li> <li>• Not appropriate for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities</li> </ul>
<b>Supported Housing</b>	✓	✓	✓	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Not appropriate for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities</li> <li>• Cannot be on the sex offender registry</li> </ul>
<b>Permanent Supportive Housing</b>	Will accept any mental health diagnosis		✓	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For single, unaccompanied adults</li> <li>• No screening for credit, rental history or justice system involvement</li> <li>• <b>Referrals are exclusively through Coordinated Entry system</b></li> </ul>
