



## Housing List FAQ

### 1. How do I get onto the list?

- a. Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH): Individuals must register with the coordinated entry through the Office of Homeless Services. Information at: [Coordinated Entry System \(Office of Homeless Services\) | Nashville.gov](https://www.tn.gov/topics/homeless-services/coordinated-entry-system)
- b. Supported Housing (SH): Call Park Center Intake at 629-243-2659 or stop by the intake office at 948 Woodland St, Nashville, 37206. \*\*\*TennCare must approve level of care, typically reserved for individuals with acute symptoms who are unable to manage their own healthcare and medication mgmt.
- c. Early Adult (EA(18-25)): Call Park Center Intake at 629-243-2659 or stop by the intake office at 948 Woodland St., Nashville 37206.

### 2. Are there income requirements?

- a. PSH: Yes, \$375/month for 2/3-bedroom units and 30% of income for 1-bedroom units.
- b. SH: Yes, TennCare Required Rent is \$500-\$700 / month depending on location.
- c. EA: No

### 3. How long is the wait list?

- a. Length of time will vary depending on factors including severity of need, demographics alignment, and specific unit types desired.

### 4. How does housing work?

- a. PSH: Independent living with regular staff support visits, staff on call 24/7.
- b. SH: Group living with 24/7 support and supervision
- c. PSH, SH, and EA require members to participate in services to support their road to recovery from mental illness and substance use disorder.

### 5. Does housing require insurance?

- a. PSH: No, there is no insurance requirement.
- b. SH: Yes, members are required to have TennCare to be eligible for SH.
- c. EA: No
